West Boynton Hoodoo

Take the Boynton trail past the end of Enchantment. If you look on the western side of the canyon you will see a large hoodoo standing off the red cliffs. This is your destination, but you will approach it from the north to avoid the thick manzanita scrub you see along the left side of the trail. Take the Boynton trail for about ½ mile beyond the end of Enchantment. Just about opposite the trail to the stone dwellings on your right you will find a trail leading up to the red rocks on the left. Climb up this trail until you are below the cliffs and then follow the cliffs around the contours all the way to the hoodoo. Most of the time you will be on a trail below the cliffs and sometimes you will be able to take the lower ledges along to your destination.

Once you are at the hoodoo look high up in the cliffs. There you will see a rock wall that must be a dwelling. How do you get there? That is the question.
