12 week session (summer term): May 9 – July 27


Tuition Credit

For Summer Term 2018, instructional fees, and general and non-resident surcharges for Columbus campus undergraduates will be discounted by 25 percent compared to autumn and spring semesters. How to Search for Courses by Session


To find the list of courses being offered during summer term, follow these steps.

Step 1: Go to www.buckeyelink.osu.edu and click on “Enrollment and Registration”



Step 2: Click on “Class Search (SIS)”

You can click on “Class Search – Mobile friendly” instead if you’d prefer, but I find that search engine harder to use and it doesn’t seem to be as accurate.



Step 3: Choose “summer 2018” as the term and “Columbus” as the campus unless you want to take a class on a regional campus. Then click “Additional Search Criteria”. The “session” drop-down menu will allow you to narrow down your search if you’re looking to take a course during a specific session within summer term.

When Can I Register for Summer Courses?

Each student will have their own unique scheduling appointment - a specific day and time after which you can register for classes. To check yours, log in to your Student Center and click on the “details” link in the blue Enrollment Information box on the right-hand side of your screen.



Then choose the “Summer 2018 Term” bubble and click “continue”. Your scheduling appointment will be shown in the “Appointment Begins” column. You should be able to register for summer classes after the day and time listed.

Don't forget that scheduling windows are assigned based on rank. Student athletes, those with disabilities, and honors students schedule first. From there, seniors schedule, then juniors, sophomores, then freshmen.

Summer Physics Courses at OSU

The OSU Department of Physics is offering the following courses during the summer of 2018 that may be of interest to physics and engineering physics majors.

Cost of Summer Classes

Students are charged for tuition and fees for summer classes in the same fashion as autumn and spring classes. If you're below full-time (12 credit hours), you will be charged per credit hour.
